OUR JOURNEY TOWARDS GETTING THE SCHOOLS TO TEACH



2015 LEARN! 2022 PROJECT

HOURLESS SUBJECT IN DENMARK = IN REALITY FEW HOURS TO TEACH TSaME
OUR FOCUS IS PRIMARILY ON GRADE 0-9
APP. 67.000 pupils pr. grade = 630.000 pupils

PHASE 1:

FOCUS ON QUALITY MATERIALS



- Digitalization
- Free of charge
- All tested and evaluated some dumped/new developed
 - Adapted 1-to-1 to national learning goals for TSaME
 - Interdisciplinary focus
 - New teachers' manuals & new assignment sheets







PHASE 2:


MONITORING USE OF MATERIALS



- Digitally (UNI-login)
- Quant surveys to schools

INSIGHTS:

- · Not all schools teach
- Teaching is primarily done in the lower grades and little in the higher grades (where the risk is highest!)



PHASE 3:

MARKETING STRATEGY



Schools - teachers:

- Start of term physical package with posters, stickers, teaching materials, teacher's manuals etc. to all schools— with special focus on grade 0 + oldest pupils, but also grade 5-6
- "Win a sub" (a substitute teacher) for grade 7-9
- Small films marketing our TSaME materials
- Teachers' exhibitions
- Teachers' seminars
- Local network meetings for schools, municipality and local police
- Advertising (print and SoMe) teachers

RESULT:

 Did not increase teaching (unfortunately), and was very expensive...



PHASE 4:

NEW STRATEGY




"Burger-model":

- Prioritize TSaME: Minimum (Pedestrian test (5-7 hr), Cycling test (10 hr), Risk factors/ reflection/LIVE (2-4 hr) = LEARN Principl.) All part of nat. learning goals/curriculum
- Top-down bottom-up
- Annual strategy and action plan day
- Quant surveys: Schools and director's of municipalities' school depart

For teachers (examples):

- Traffic safety teachers' courses
- Annual TSaME wheel
- Webinars
- Newsletters (2000 teachers)





RESULT

Status quo = Maintaining level of teaching in bumpy period (national school reform, COVID19, grade 0 teachers stopping etc.)

PHASE 5:

KPIS FOR TSAME IN NATIONAL ACTION PLAN



States that no ministry oversees follow-up (ETSC LEARN! Report)

KPI no. 7

Prevalence of road safety education in primary schools subject to the Ministry of Children and Education's professional Common Goals for Road Safety Education (unfortunately only in Danish: GSK FællesMål Færdselslære (emu.dk) and GSK læseplan Færdselslære 2020 (emu.dk):

- Proportion of schools that, as a minimum, use/teach walking/pedestrian test (grade 0-1)
- Proportion of schools that, as a minimum, use/teach walking cycling test (grade 5-6)
- Proportion of schools that, as a minimum, use/teach "Road Safety LIVE"/"360 Degrees" (= the pupils are being taught risk factors and possible consequences of oneself and others behavior in traffic, e.g. via video carrier material or guest teacher dealing with a real traffic accident (grade 8-9)
- Proportion of schools that have a road safety teacher.

Please note that in Denmark our primary schools are defined as grade 0-10 (pupils aged 5-15/16 years old)

The Danish Road Safety Commission has selected the following eight KPIs:

- 1. Speed Percentage of car drivers observing the speed limit on roads with different speed limits
- 2. Helmet use Percentage of cyclists (including e-bikes and speed pedelecs), drivers of small mopeds and electric scooters, respectively, using bicycle helmets or helmet air-bags in urban traffic.
- 3. Affected by alcohol, drugs and medicine The ratio between the number of seriously injured and fatalities in accidents, in which one or more of the involved persons are affected by alcohol, drugs or medicine, and the total number of seriously injured and fatalities.
- Distraction/inattention Behavioural development for the following distractors at speeds above 40km/h; Use of hand-held and hands-free mobile phones for speaking, reading and texting on telephone, operating GPS and other clear distractions (getting things out or putting things aside).
- 5. Conditions of the car fleet Percentage of the car fleet older than 10 years.
- 6. Use of seatbelt Percentage of drivers of passenger cars using seatbelts.
- 7. Road safety education in primary school
- 8. Municipal road safety action plans The proportion of Danish municipalities that has adopted a road safety action plan.




PHASE 6:

- **6. School Patrol** (no points for this question)

8 questions - MAX 400 points in total:

- Network meetings: Joint meeting(s) about traffic education, where the schools' traffic contact teachers, the police and possibly others have participated
- 2. District council/local council: Meeting with the police, where you have discussed traffic safety at the municipality's schools (e.g. traffic safety around the schools, school patrol, holding a walking test, cycling test, etc.)
- Muncipalities' director of schools: Communicated with all the head teachers from the municipality's primary schools about whether the individual primary school implements traffic education at all levels? (e.g. by putting it on the agenda for a school head meeting)
- **I. Traffic policy schools:** Motivated schools to formulate one
- 5. Road safety campaigns targeting the schools
- 6. Politically adopted traffic safety plan (also called mobility plan, traffic plan, etc.), which states that all primary schools in the municipality must carry out traffic education at all levels
- **7. Other measures** which contribute to the municipality's school children being safe in traffic
- 8. Who has answered this test

PHASE 3:

STRUCTURAL: Municipalities' School Traffic Test

STATUS

- Impressive participation rate:
 - Municipalities: 97 out of 98
 - Primary schools (grade 0-9, both public and private): 1177 = 75 %



- Results ultimo September
- Municipalities get their own individual report
- Ministry of Education & Danish Road Safety Commission (ministry will make follow-up in relation to schools who
 have not participated/taught)
- Press, communication, counselling etc.
