


# Killed and seriously injured: Age and girls/boys



In Denmark 17-24-yearold = the most vulnerable group in traffic

Amongst children we especially see an increase in accidents from when they are 12 years old

# Killed and seriously injured by means of transport



When Danish children enter their teen years, they can multiply the risk of getting injured or killed in traffic by 10 compared to when they were 6 years old

# 12-17-years old especially:

- mopeds/scooters (licence from 15 years old)
- bicycles
- cars
- pedestrians

# 18-24-years old especially:

- cars
- bicycles

- GRADE 0-9 (AGE 5/6-15-YEAR-OLD): PRIMARY SCHOOL AND LOWER SECONDARY SCHOOL

- Danish national goals for Traffic Safety education:
  - (https://emu.dk/grundskole/faerdselslaere/laeseplan-og-vejledning):
  - It is **mandatory** to teach (and it has been so since 1940!), but there is unfortunately not a requirement in terms of hours pr. year pr. grade
- UN/EU goals:
  - The majority of European countries have signed the UNECE's Convention on Road Traffic (also known as the "1968 Vienna" Convention) and have thereby committed to provide road safety education:

"Article 3(5bis). Contracting Parties will take the necessary measures to ensure that road safety education be provided on a **systematic and continuous basis**, particularly in schools **at all levels.**"

- Both EU and Danish goals for 5/6 to 15 years old:
  - All children/youngsters should be taught in traffic safety.

### MINIMUM TSAME WE RECOMMEND FOR 12-15-YEAR-OLD

Grade 8-9 (14-15-year-old) **Note: Many schools max** 2-4 lessons/hours (!)

Visit in class by "Sikker Trafik LIVE" ambassador, 2 lessons



"360 degrees"

(Soc. Science, Religion), 2-4 lessons



- and/or
- Pupils meet a person who lives with a visible injury after a traffic accident.
- · They hear the story of the accident and of having to live a different life than one had imagined.
- There is ongoing dialogue throughout the visit, where pupils also gain knowledge about risks in traffic and the possible consequences when things go wrong.

- Pupils watch 3 small film clips and analyze a real traffic (moped) Accident.
- The pupils meet the main character, relatives and professionals who are all affected by the accident.
- Teaching is based on dialogue and varying teaching methods.
- The goal is for the students to work with the many consequences a serious traffic accident can have and to reflect on their own behavior in traffic.





"Win a sub" (a substitute teacher) - for grade 7-9 = did not work as intended

### **HOW MANY 12–15-YEAR-OLD DANISH PUPILS ARE TAUGHT IN TSAME?**

Grade 6 (12-year-old)

"The bicycle test" (theory & practice in traffic), 10-12 lessons



63 % of all pupils in Denmark in 2022/2023

(2021/2022: 59 %)

• Public schools: 68 %

Private schools: 51 %

**Grade 8-9** (14-15-year-old)

Visit in class by "Sikker Trafik LIVE" ambassador, 10-12 lessons

"360 degrees" (Soc. Science, Religion), 2-4 lessons





**53** % of all pupils in Denmark in 2022/2023 (2021/2022: 42 %) Public schools: 55 %, Private schools: 49 %

#### **Sikker Trafik LIVE**

- 2022/2023: 36.683 pupils have attended a visit by LIVE (covering 831 school visits)
- Pupil evaluation: Just after visit + 6-12 months after visit

- No national goals for Traffic Safety education in upper secondary education.

- IN UPPER SECONDARY EDUCATION (HIGH SCHOOLS, VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS, COLLEGES) = 16-18 YEARS OLD

Vocational upper secondary education (eud) (e.g. building & construction, social helper, carpenter etc.), agricultural colleges (targeting analysis: 7 out of 10 accidents) etc. (16-25 years old)

All upper secondary education is offered to get visits by our Sikker Trafik LIVE (marketing twice a year to schools) Higher vocational education qualifying for access to higher education (universities etc.): Higher General Examination Programme (stx), Higher Technical Examination Programme (htx), Higher Commercial Examination Programme (hhx)

(16-18/19 years old)

#### Visit = 3 hours:

- Preferably max 40 students (in practice 10-60 pr. visit)
- Young presenter: Facts & excercises
- Story by ambassador = a relative
- Including 2 breaks app. 20 min. each
- Mobile survey evaluation at end (& after 6-12 months)
- 2022: 128 visits (including 17 on agriculture colleges)





#### Visit = 1½ hours:

- 150-200 students
- Young presenter: On-spot survey of students knowledge/attititudes/behaviour + facts
- Story by ambassador = a relative
- Mobile survey evaluation at end (& 6-12 months after)
- 2022: 17 visits



### OTHER TRAFFIC SAFETY FOCUS IN DENMARK

- IN UPPER SECONDARY EDUCATION (HIGH SCHOOLS, VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS, COLLEGES) = 16-18 YEARS OLD

ONE OF DENMARK'S 12 POLICE DISTRICTS HELP "NUDGE" UPPER SECONDARY EDUCATION IN THEIR DISTRICT TO GET VISITS BY SIKKER TRAFIK LIVE & TO ENCOURAGE THE SCHOOLS TO FOCUS ON TRAFFIC SAFETY

The police district has made a **network for headmasters and education managers** from the upper secondary education schools in their police district.

The network meets 4 times a year. Not all schools participate, but there is an increase in schools participating. Sikker Trafik participates in some of the meetings. Result = large increase in LIVE visits.

#### The police also offer the schools:

- Short presentations by the police during the schools' morning assembly. As part of this they show our short 3 minutes film with young girl Pernille who lost her brother in a traffic accident
- A **mobile police station** at the schools, so the students can speak to the police in breaks (e.g. about traffic safety).

# OTHER TRAFFIC SAFETY FOCUS IN DENMARK

- IN UPPER SECONDARY EDUCATION (HIGH SCHOOLS, VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS, COLLEGES) = 16-18 YEARS OLD

DENMARK'S LARGEST MUNICIPALITY – MUNCIPALITY OF COPENHAGEN – INCLUDE TRAFFIC SAFETY WHEN THEIR HEALTH CARE ADMINISTRATION VISITS UPPER SECONDARY EDUCATION SCHOOLS

When the Municipality of Copenhagen have visits to all the Upper Secondary Education Schools in their municipality regarding young people's alcohol consumption, they include a road safety message about not riding drunk on a bicycle and they show our film regarding this.

The Municipality of Copenhagen has made the schools show the film on the schools' infomedia screens.

(We also use (and pay for using) the schools' infomedia screens when we show our campaign films for 17-14-year-old).







## OTHER TRAFFIC SAFETY EDUCATION

- FOR 15-18 YEARS OLD (AND OLDER)

#### Moped driver's licence

(from 15 years old for 30 km/h moped)

- Material developed by us
- Twice a year we educate youth schoolteachers, who teach young people
- The teaching follows EU's Moped Directive





### Car driver's licence (and for MC & Tractor)

(from 17 years old)

 We have developed "Traffic-related first aid part of driver's license training", "Education in why do traffic asccidents happen/risk assesment" and homepage for 17-year-old and their parents regarding taking driver's licence at 17 years old

- HIGHER EDUCATION: FOR INSTANCE UNIVERSITIES & BUSINESS SCHOOLS = 19/20-25 YEARS OLD (OR OLDER)

**TEACHER'S SEMINARS (education for future teachers in primary and lower secondary schools)** 

 All seminars are offered visit by Rådet for Sikker Trafik; 1day course for students who would like to teach TSaME

### "HELP A HELMET-LESS"/"HELMET TO GO"

- Pop-up-shops on selected higher education. 2-3 days
- Sale of bicycle helmets for 150 Danish kroner (=20 Euro)
- 350 to 450 helmets sold at each shop
- 98 % who did not have a helmet before still use the helmet (in some degree) 7 months after the event
- 88% have talked to others about helmets
- 97 % likes the pop-up shop much or very much.
